### **TeleSouth Communications announces largest acquisition in company history**

On March 1, TeleSouth Communications, Inc. officially added five stations to its network of radio stations across the state of Mississippi.

TeleSouth purchased WANG-AM, WTNI-AM, WCPR-FM, WGBL-FM and WQBB-FM from Alpha Media. All of the stations are located along the Mississippi gulf coast and join TeleSouth's WOSM 103.1 FM which broadcasts the SuperTalk Mississippi network (also owned by TeleSouth), a 50,000 watt station based in Ocean Springs.

TeleSouth Communications, Inc. began nearly 40 years ago as Mississippi Networks – with college sports and long-form talk radio programming.

Steve Davenport formed a partnership in 1985 to purchase the Mississippi Network, eventually becoming the sole owner in 2008.

TeleSouth Communications, Inc. is the parent company of SuperTalk Mississippi, News Mississippi the Mississippi Agri-News network and 29 stations across the Magnolia State.
